  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Puppies Assisting
  - 5 Wounded Servicemembers Act of 2019" or the "PAWS
  - 6 Act of 2019".

1	SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
2	TO PROVIDE SERVICE DOGS TO VETERANS
3	WITH MENTAL ILLNESSES WHO DO NOT HAVE
4	MOBILITY IMPAIRMENTS.
5	Section 1714 of title 38, United States Code, is
6	amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
7	section:
8	"(e) The Secretary may provide a service dog to a
9	veteran under subsection $(c)(3)$ regardless of whether the
10	veteran has a mobility impairment.".
