**AN ACT**

To direct the Director of the National Science Foundation to support research on opioid addiction, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE; FINDINGS.**

4 (a) ~~SHORT TITLE.~~—This Act may be cited as the  
5 “~~Expanding Findings for Federal Opioid Research and~~  
6 ~~Treatment Act~~” or the “~~EFFORT Act~~”.

7 (b) ~~FINDINGS.~~—The Congress finds that—

1           (1) research gaps currently exist in the preven-  
2           tion and treatment of opioid addiction;

3           (2) the National Science Foundation’s research  
4           on opioid addiction has increased understanding of  
5           the neuroscience of addiction; substance abuse inter-  
6           vention; the role of illicit supply networks; the sec-  
7           ondary effects on families; the use of technology to  
8           address the opioid epidemic; and options for alter-  
9           native, non-addictive therapeutics for pain; and

10          (3) the National Science Foundation and the  
11          National Institutes of Health have recognized that  
12          fundamental questions in basic, clinical, and  
13          translational research would benefit greatly from  
14          multidisciplinary approaches and collaboration.

15 **SEC. 2. NSF SUPPORT OF RESEARCH ON OPIOID ADDIC-**  
16 **TION.**

17          The Director of the National Science Foundation, in  
18          consultation with the Director of the National Institutes  
19          of Health, shall support merit-reviewed and competitively  
20          awarded research on the science of opioid addiction.

21 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE; FINDINGS.**

22          (a) *SHORT TITLE.*—This Act may be cited as the “*Ex-*  
23 *anding Findings for Federal Opioid Research and Treat-*  
24 *ment Act*” or the “*EFFORT Act*”.

25          (b) *FINDINGS.*—Congress finds that—
