## A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Honoring Harriet Tub-
- 5 man Act".

## SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF STATUE OF HARRIET TUBMAN IN

- 2 NATIONAL STATUARY HALL.
- 3 (a) Obtaining Statue.—Not later than 2 years
- 4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Joint Com-
- 5 mittee on the Library shall enter into an agreement to
- 6 obtain a statue of Harriet Tubman, under such terms and
- 7 conditions as the Joint Committee considers appropriate
- 8 consistent with applicable law.
- 9 (b) Placement.—The Joint Committee shall place
- 10 the statue obtained under subsection (a) in the United
- 11 States Capitol in a suitable permanent location in Na-
- 12 tional Statuary Hall.
- 13 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- 14 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—There are authorized to be ap-
- 15 propriated such sums as may be necessary to carry out
- 16 this Act.
- 17 (b) Continuing Availability of Funds.—Any
- 18 amounts appropriated pursuant to the authorization under
- 19 this section shall remain available until expended.
