## A BILL

To amend title 13, United States Code, to require that any questionnaire used for a decennial census of population contains a question regarding citizenship, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Citizens Count Census  
5 Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. CITIZENSHIP STATUS ON CENSUS QUESTION-**  
2 **NAIRES.**

3 Section 141 of title 13, United States Code, is  
4 amended—

5 (1) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-  
6 section (h); and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-  
8 lowing:

9 “(g) In conducting the 2020 decennial census and  
10 each decennial census thereafter, the Secretary shall in-  
11 clude in any questionnaire distributed or otherwise used  
12 for the purpose of determining the total population by  
13 States a checkbox or other similar option for respondents  
14 to indicate whether the respondent is a citizen or national  
15 of the United States.”.
