4 This Act may be cited as the "Citizens Count Census5 Act of 2019".

3 Section 141 of title 13, United States Code, is4 amended—

5 (1) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-6 section (h); and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-8 lowing:

9 "(g) In conducting the 2020 decennial census and 10 each decennial census thereafter, the Secretary shall in-11 clude in any questionnaire distributed or otherwise used 12 for the purpose of determining the total population by 13 States a checkbox or other similar option for respondents 14 to indicate whether the respondent is a citizen or national 15 of the United States.".
