## AN ACT

To provide that the amount of time that an elderly offender must serve before being eligible for placement in home detention is to be reduced by the amount of good time credits earned by the prisoner, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. GOOD CONDUCT TIME CREDITS FOR CERTAIN**  
2 **ELDERLY NONVIOLENT OFFENDERS.**

3 Section 231(g)(5)(A)(ii) of the Second Chance Act of  
4 2007 (34 U.S.C. 60541(g)(5)(A)(ii)) is amended by strik-  
5 ing “to which the offender was sentenced” and inserting  
6 “reduced by any credit toward the service of the prisoner’s  
7 sentence awarded under section 3624(b) of title 18,  
8 United States Code”.

9 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

10 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of  
11 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,  
12 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement  
13 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this  
14 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record  
15 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-  
16 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the  
17 vote on passage.
