AN ACT

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service
located at 321 South 1st Street in Montrose, Colorado,
as the “Sergeant David Kinterknecht Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SERGEANT DAVID KINTERKNECHT POST OF-**
2 **FICE.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 321 South 1st Street in
5 Montrose, Colorado, shall be known and designated as the
6 “Sergeant David Kinterknecht Post Office”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant David
11 Kinterknecht Post Office”.

12 (c) REPEAL OF PREVIOUS DESIGNATION.—Section 1
13 of Public Law 115–366 is hereby repealed, and the des-
14 ignation made and references deemed in subsections (a)
15 and (b), respectively, of such section shall have no force
16 or effect.
