## A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to allow a recipient of an institutional aid grant to use funds under such grant to establish, improve, or expand partnerships with child care providers.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Empower Parents in  
5 College Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. INSTITUTIONAL AID GRANT AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES.**

3 Section 311(c) of the Higher Education Act of 1965  
4 (20 U.S.C. 1057(c)) is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating paragraph (13) as para-  
6 graph (14); and

7 (2) by inserting after paragraph (12) the fol-  
8 lowing:

9 “(13) Establishing, improving, or expanding  
10 partnerships with child care providers.”.
