## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify when educational assistance is available for an individual who pursues an approved program of education leading to a degree while on active duty in the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reserve and Guard  
5 GI Bill Housing Fairness Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE**  
2 **FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO PURSUE AN AP-**  
3 **PROVED PROGRAM OF EDUCATION LEADING**  
4 **TO A DEGREE WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY.**

5 Section 3313(e) of title 38, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7 (1) in the heading, by inserting “FOR A PERIOD  
8 OF MORE THAN 30 DAYS” after “ACTIVE DUTY”;

9 (2) in paragraph (1), by inserting “for a period  
10 of more than 30 days” after “active duty”; and

11 (3) in paragraph (2), in the matter preceding  
12 subparagraph (A), by inserting “for a period of  
13 more than 30 days” after “active duty”.
