To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide that the authority of the Director of the National Institute on Minority Health and Health Disparities to make certain research endowments applies with respect to both current and former centers of excellence, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NIMHD Research En-
5 dowment Revitalization Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESEARCH ENDOWMENTS AT BOTH CURRENT AND**
2 **FORMER CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE.**

3 Paragraph (1) of section 464z–3(h) of the Public
4 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 285t(h)) is amended to
5 read as follows:

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Director of the Insti-
7 tute may carry out a program to facilitate minority
8 health disparities research and other health dispari-
9 ties research by providing for research endow-
10 ments—

11 “(A) at current or former centers of excel-
12 lence under section 736; and

13 “(B) at current or former centers of excel-
14 lence under section 464z–4.”.

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
