Mr. ARRINGTON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Transportation and Infrastructure, Agriculture, Science, Space, and Technology, Natural Resources, Education and Labor, Financial Services, Foreign Affairs, Ways and Means, and Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

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## A BILL

To extend authorization for the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund of 2001 through fiscal year 2025, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Honor the Heroes Act  
5 of 2019”.

1   **SEC. 2. SEPTEMBER 11TH VICTIM COMPENSATION FUND OF**  
2                   **2001.**

3                 (a) AUTHORIZATION AND FUNDING.—Section 410 of  
4   the Air Transportation Safety and System Stabilization  
5   Act (49 U.S.C. 40101 note) is amended—

6                         (1) in subsection (c), by striking “such sums as  
7   may be necessary for fiscal year 2019 and each fis-  
8   cal year thereafter through fiscal year 2092” and in-  
9   serting “\$11,991,000,000 for fiscal year 2020 and  
10   each fiscal year thereafter through fiscal year  
11   2025”; and

12                         (2) by striking subsection (e).

13                 (b) EXTENDING FILING DEADLINE.—Section  
14   405(a)(3)(B) of the Air Transportation Safety and Sys-  
15   tem Stabilization Act (49 U.S.C. 40101 note) is amended  
16   by striking “October 1, 2090” and inserting “5 years after  
17   the date of enactment of the Honor the Heroes Act of  
18   2019”.

19                 (c) COMPENSATION REDUCED BY SPECIAL MASTER  
20   DUE TO LACK OF FUNDING.—Section 406(d)(2)(C)(ii) of  
21   the Air Transportation Safety and System Stabilization  
22   Act (49 U.S.C. 40101 note) is amended by striking “each  
23   year thereafter” and inserting “not less than once every  
24   5 years thereafter”.

25                 (d) ADJUSTMENT OF GROSS INCOME LIMITATION.—  
26   Section 405(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Air Transportation Safety

1 and System Stabilization Act (40 U.S.C. 40101 note) is  
2 amended—

3                     (1) by striking “In considering” and inserting  
4                     the following:

5                         “(I) IN GENERAL.—Subject to  
6                         subclause (II), in considering”; and

7                     (2) by adding at the end the following:

8                         “(II) ADJUSTMENT.—The Special Master shall adjust the amount of  
9                         the limitation under subclause (I) not  
10                         more frequently than once every 2  
11                         years to reflect the percentage by  
12                         which the Consumer Price Index for  
13                         All Urban Consumers published by  
14                         the Department of Labor for the  
15                         month of October immediately preceding the date of adjustment exceeds  
16                         the Consumer Price Index for All  
17                         Urban Consumers published by the  
18                         Department of Labor for the month  
19                         of October that immediately precedes  
20                         the date that is 2 years before the  
21                         date of adjustment.”.

1   **SEC. 3. OFFSET.**

2           (a) IN GENERAL.—For fiscal year 2020 and each fis-  
3    cal year thereafter, the discretionary budget authority pro-  
4    vided to each of the following for fiscal year 2019 shall  
5    be reduced by 3 percent, with the reduction applied pro-  
6    portionately to each account:

7               (1) The Environmental Protection Agency.

8               (2) The Department of the Interior.

9               (3) The Department of Labor.

10              (4) The Department of Housing and Urban De-  
11   velopment.

12              (5) The Department of Commerce.

13           (b) DEPOSIT INTO FUND.—An amount equal to the  
14   total amount of any reduction under subsection (a) shall  
15   be deposited into the Victim Compensation Fund estab-  
16   lished under section 410 of the Air Transportation Safety  
17   and System Stabilization Act (49 U.S.C. 40101 note).

18           (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 410(b) of  
19   the Air Transportation Safety and System Stabilization  
20   Act (49 U.S.C. 40101 note) is amended by adding at the  
21   end the following:

22               “(3) An amount equal to the total amount of  
23   any reduction under section 3 of the Honor the He-  
24   roes Act of 2019.”.
