A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to eliminate the resource requirement with respect to subsidy-eligible individuals under part D of the Medicare program.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Better Tools to Lower
5 Costs Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATING THE RESOURCE REQUIREMENT WITH**
2 **RESPECT TO SUBSIDY-ELIGIBLE INDIVID-**
3 **UALS UNDER PART D OF THE MEDICARE**
4 **PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1860D–14(a)(3)(A)(iii) of the Social Security
6 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–114(a)(3)(A)(iii)) is amended by
7 inserting “in the case of a plan year beginning before Jan-
8 uary 1, 2022,” before “meets”.

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
