To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to change certain eligibility provisions for loan forgiveness for teachers, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Teacher Debt Relief
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOAN FORGIVENESS FOR TEACHERS.**

7 The Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1001
8 et seq.) is amended—

9 (1) in section 428J(g)(2) (20 U.S.C. 1078–
10 10(g)(2))—

1 (A) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “or”
2 after the semicolon at the end;

3 (B) by striking subparagraph (B); and

4 (C) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as
5 subparagraph (B);

6 (2) in section 455(m) (20 U.S.C. 1087e(m)), in
7 paragraph (4), by striking “both this subsection and
8 section 428J, 428K, 428L, or 460” and inserting
9 “both this subsection and section 428K or 428L”;
10 and

11 (3) in section 460(g)(2) (20 U.S.C.
12 1087j(g)(2))—

13 (A) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “or”
14 after the semicolon at the end;

15 (B) by striking subparagraph (B); and

16 (C) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as
17 subparagraph (B).
