A BILL

To extend the limited wraparound coverage pilot program for an additional 5 years, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wraparound Health
5 Coverage Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF LIMITED WRAPAROUND COVERAGE**
7 **PILOT PROGRAM FOR ADDITIONAL 5 YEARS.**

8 The provisions of paragraph (b)(3)(vii) of section
9 146.145 of title 45, Code of Federal Regulations (as in

1 effect on the date of enactment of this Act), shall apply
2 to limited wraparound coverage (as described in such pro-
3 visions) that, with respect to health insurance coverage de-
4 scribed in paragraph (b)(3)(vii)(D)(1) or (b)(3)(vii)(D)(2)
5 of such section (as such paragraphs are in effect on such
6 date of enactment)—

7 (1) is first offered no earlier than January 1,
8 2016, and no later than December 31, 2023; and

9 (2) ends no later than on the later of—

10 (A) December 31, 2024; or

11 (B) the date on which the last employment
12 agreement relating to such health insurance
13 coverage terminates after the date on which
14 such limited wraparound coverage is first of-
15 fered under paragraph (1) (determined without
16 regard to any extension agreed to after the date
17 on which such limited wraparound coverage is
18 so first offered).

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
