## A BILL

To prohibit Federal agencies from using funds for grants related to the history of wine in countries outside of the United States, whether insects are attracted to artificial light, or the levels of stress on humans when discussing politics in social situations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Taxpayer Savings Im-  
5 provement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR CER-**  
2 **TAIN GRANTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—During any fiscal year beginning  
4 on or after the date of enactment of this Act, Federal  
5 funds may not be used by any agency to award a grant  
6 that would fund a study—

7 (1) on a history of wine in countries outside of  
8 the United States;

9 (2) on determining whether insects are at-  
10 tracted to artificial light; or

11 (3) on determining the levels of stress on hu-  
12 mans when discussing politics in social situations.

13 (b) DEFINITION OF AGENCY.—In this Act, the term  
14 “agency” has the meaning given that term in section 551  
15 of title 5, United States Code.
