A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to delist certain endangered species and threatened species.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Endangered Species
5 Accountability Reform Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DELISTING OF SPECIES.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, not later
8 than 30 days after the date that is 5 years after the date
9 on which the Secretary of the Interior determines that a
10 species is an endangered species or a threatened species

1 pursuant to section 4 of the Endangered Species Act of
2 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1533) the Secretary of the Interior shall
3 delist such species.
