A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Treasury to submit a report
to Congress regarding the Greenhouse Gas Reporting
Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pricing Greenhouse
5 Gases Report Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON GREENHOUSE GAS REPORTING PRO-**
7 **GRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
9 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the

1 Treasury (or the Secretary’s delegate) shall submit a re-
2 port to Congress on the utility of the data from the Green-
3 house Gas Reporting Program for determining the amount
4 of greenhouse gases emitted by each taxpayer for the pur-
5 pose of imposing a fee on such taxpayers with respect to
6 such emissions. Such report shall include a detailed de-
7 scription and analysis of any administrative or other chal-
8 lenges associated with using such data for such purpose.

9 (b) GREENHOUSE GAS REPORTING PROGRAM.—For
10 purposes of this section, the term “Greenhouse Gas Re-
11 porting Program” means the reporting program estab-
12 lished by the Administrator of the Environmental Protec-
13 tion Agency under title II of division F of the Consolidated
14 Appropriations Act, 2008.

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
