A BILL

To require executive agencies to reduce cost-sharing requirements for certain grants with certain nonprofit organizations 25 percent, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Empowering Non-
5 profits Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF COST-SHARING REQUIREMENTS**
2 **FOR GRANTS.**

3 (a) REDUCTION OF COST-SHARING REQUIREMENT.—
4 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act and
5 ending 5 years thereafter, the head of an executive agency
6 shall reduce any cost-sharing requirement 25 percent for
7 an eligible nonprofit organization for grants made directly
8 to that organization.

9 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

10 (1) ELIGIBLE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.—The
11 term “eligible nonprofit organization” means a non-
12 profit organization that is located in a State with
13 more than 20 percent of individuals living below the
14 Federal poverty line.

15 (2) EXECUTIVE AGENCY.—The term “executive
16 agency” has the meaning given in section 133 of
17 title 41, United States Code.

18 (3) NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.—The term
19 “nonprofit organization” means an organization that
20 is described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Rev-
21 enue Code of 1968 and exempt from taxation under
22 section 501(a) of such Code.

23 (4) STATE.—The term “State” means each of
24 the several States, the District of Columbia, each

1 commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United
2 States, and each federally recognized Tribe.
