To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide accrual of annual and sick leave for Federal employees of an agency subject to a lapse in appropriations, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Continuing Federal
- 5 Employee Leave Policy Act of 2019".

SEC. 2. LEAVE ACCRUAL FOR FEDERAL EMPLOYEES SUB-

- 2 **JECT TO GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN.**
- 3 (a) Annual Leave.—Section 6303 of title 5, United
- 4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 5 lowing:
- 6 "(g) During any period of a lapse in appropriations
- 7 with respect to an agency, an employee of that agency
- 8 who, as a result of such lapse, is furloughed or excepted
- 9 from furlough shall accrue leave during that period at the
- 10 rate prescribed by this section.".
- 11 (b) Sick Leave.—Section 6307 of title 5, United
- 12 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 13 lowing:
- 14 "(e) During any period of a lapse in appropriations
- 15 with respect to an agency, an employee of that agency
- 16 who, as a result of such lapse, is furloughed or excepted
- 17 from furlough shall accrue leave during that period at the
- 18 rate prescribed by this section.".
- 19 (c) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by this
- 20 section shall apply to any lapse in appropriations begin-
- 21 ning on or after December 22, 2018.
