3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining GI Bill
5 Processing Act of 2020”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELECTRONIC CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY FOR**
2 **DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS EDU-**
3 **CATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.**

4 Not later than August 1, 2021, the Secretary of Vet-
5 erans Affairs shall ensure that any person who is entitled
6 to educational assistance under chapter 30, 33, or 35 of
7 title 38, United States Code, or section 1606 of title 10,
8 United States Code, is able to access an electronic version
9 of the certificate of eligibility showing the person's entitle-
10 ment to such assistance.
