A BILL

To amend the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 to prohibit assistance to nonprofits, foreign nongovernmental organizations, and quasi-autonomous nongovernmental organizations that promote or perform abortions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Life in
5 Global Health Assistance Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON ASSISTANCE TO FOREIGN NON-**
2 **PROFITS, FOREIGN NONGOVERNMENTAL OR-**
3 **GANIZATIONS, AND QUASI-AUTONOMOUS**
4 **NONGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS THAT**
5 **PROMOTE OR PERFORM ABORTIONS.**

6 Chapter 1 of part III of the Foreign Assistance Act
7 of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2351 et seq.) is amended by adding
8 at the end the following new section:

9 **“SEC. 620N. PROHIBITION ON ASSISTANCE TO FOREIGN**
10 **NONPROFITS, FOREIGN NONGOVERNMENTAL**
11 **ORGANIZATIONS, AND QUASI-AUTONOMOUS**
12 **NONGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS THAT**
13 **PROMOTE OR PERFORM ABORTIONS.**

14 “No assistance may be furnished under this Act to
15 any foreign nonprofit, foreign nongovernmental organiza-
16 tion, or quasi-autonomous nongovernmental organization
17 that promotes or performs abortion, except in cases of
18 rape or incest or when the life of the mother would be
19 endangered if the fetus were carried to term.”.
