Mr. DEUTCH (for himself, Mr. RESCHENTHALER, and Mr. SMITH of New Jersey) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

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## A BILL

To amend the Elder Abuse Prevention and Prosecution Act to improve the prevention of elder abuse and exploitation of individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the "Promoting Alzheimer's  
5       Awareness to Prevent Elder Abuse Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. ADDRESSING ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE IN BEST PRAC- 2 TICES.

3       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(b) of the Elder Abuse  
4 Prevention and Prosecution Act (34 U.S.C. 21711(b)) is  
5 amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A), (B),  
7 and (C) of paragraph (2) as clauses (i), (ii), and  
8 (iii), respectively, and adjusting the margin accord-  
9 ingly;

10 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (1), (2), and  
11 (3) as subparagraphs (A), (B), and (C), respectively,  
12 and adjusting the margin accordingly;

13                   (3) by striking “Not later than” and inserting  
14                   the following:

15                   “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than”;

24 (3) by adding at the end the following:

1                 “(A) IN GENERAL.—In creating or com-  
2                 piling replication guides and training materials  
3                 under paragraph (1)(B), the Elder Justice Co-  
4                 ordinator shall consult with the Secretary of  
5                 Health and Human Services, State, local, and  
6                 Tribal adult protective services, aging, social,  
7                 and human services agencies, Federal, State,  
8                 local, and Tribal law enforcement agencies, and  
9                 nationally recognized nonprofit associations  
10                 with relevant expertise, as appropriate.

11                 “(B) UPDATING.—The Elder Justice Coor-  
12                 dinator shall—

13                         “(i) review the best practices identi-  
14                 fied and replication guides and training  
15                 materials created or compiled under para-  
16                 graph (1)(B) to determine if the replica-  
17                 tion guides or training materials require  
18                 updating; and

19                         “(ii) perform any necessary updating  
20                 of the replication guides or training mate-  
21                 rials.”.

22                 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-  
23                 section (a) shall—

24                         (1) take effect on the date of enactment of this  
25                 Act; and

(2) apply on and after the date that is 1 year  
after the date of enactment of this Act.

### **3 SEC. 3. REPORT ON OUTREACH.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(c)(2) of the Elder  
5 Abuse Prevention and Prosecution Act (34 U.S.C.  
6 21711(c)(2)) is amended—

(1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) through (D) as clauses (i) through (iv), respectively, and adjusting the margin accordingly;

12                             “(A) detailing”; and

13 (3) by adding at the end the following:

14                     “(B) with respect to the report by the At-  
15                     torney General, including a link to the publicly  
16                     available best practices identified under sub-  
17                     section (b)(1)(B) and the replication guides and  
18                     training materials created or compiled under  
19                     such subsection.”.

(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by subsection (a) shall apply with respect to the report under section 101(c)(2) of the Elder Abuse Prevention and Prosecution Act (34 U.S.C. 21711(c)(2)) submitted during the

- 2 Act, and each year thereafter.

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
