## A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to require collection and reporting of demographic data for applicants of the Paycheck Protection Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PPP Data and Diver-  
5 sity Accountability Act of 2020”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTING OF DEMOGRAPHIC DATA FOR APPLI-**  
2 **CANTS TO THE PAYCHECK PROTECTION PRO-**  
3 **GRAM.**

4 Section 7(a)(36) of the Small Business Act (15  
5 U.S.C. 636(a)(36)) is amended by inserting the following  
6 new subparagraph:

7 “(T) DATA COLLECTION AND REPORT.—  
8 The Administrator shall develop and implement  
9 a process for the systematic collection of demo-  
10 graphic data of recipients of assistance under  
11 this paragraph and the number of loans ap-  
12 proved and denied under this paragraph. Such  
13 data shall specify whether applicants are  
14 women, veterans, or minorities, disaggregated  
15 by race in a manner that captures all the racial  
16 groups specified in the American Community  
17 Survey conducted by the Bureau of the Census.  
18 Not less frequently than quarterly, the Adminis-  
19 trator shall submit to Congress a report con-  
20 taining the results of this data collection.”.
