A BILL

To prohibit the Administrator of General Services from setting Continental United States (CONUS) per diem-reimbursements rates below a certain level, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES (CONUS) PER**
4 **DIEM-REIMBURSEMENT RATES.**

5 Notwithstanding in any other provision of law, in set-
6 ting the per diem rates for fiscal years 2021 to 2022 pur-
7 suant to sections 5702 and 5707 of title 5, United States
8 Code, the Administrator of General Services may not set

1 a lodging allowance rate for any location within the Conti-
2 nental United States at a level that is less than the rate
3 set by GSA Per Diem Bulletin FTR 20–01, dated August
4 8, 2019.

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
