A BILL

To observe the lives lost in the United States due to the
COVID–19 pandemic.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “COVID–19 Pandemic
5 Moment of Silence Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MOMENT OF SILENCE FOR THE VICTIMS OF THE**
2 **COVID-19 PANDEMIC.**

3 The President should issue a proclamation designating a National Day of Mourning and Lament and calling on the people of the United States to observe a moment of silence as a mark of respect to the memory of the more than 100,000 lives lost in the United States due to the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as their families.

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
