3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Pay Federal Workers5 Act".

SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION FOR FEDERAL EMPLOYEES EXCEPTED FROM FURLOUGH.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8502 of title 5, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol6 lowing:

7 "(f)(1) With respect to any lapse in appropriations
8 beginning on or after December 22, 2018, each excepted
9 Federal employee shall be, solely for the purpose of deter10 mining eligibility for unemployment compensation under
11 this subchapter, deemed for the duration of the lapse in
12 appropriations to be—

13 "(A) totally separated from Federal service; and
14 "(B) eligible for unemployment compensation
15 benefits under this subchapter with no waiting pe16 riod for such eligibility to accrue.

17 "(2) In this subsection, the term 'excepted Federal18 employee' means a Federal employee who—

"(A) is an excepted employee or an employee
performing emergency work, as such terms are defined by the Office of Personnel Management; and
"(B) is not being paid due to a lapse in appropriations.".

(b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub section (a) shall apply to weeks of unemployment begin ning on or after December 22, 2018.
