An Act

To extend the authority for the establishment by the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation of a commemorative work to commemorate the mission of the Peace Corps and the ideals on which the Peace Corps was founded, and for other purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the “Peace Corps Commemorative Work Extension Act”.

**SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF
COMMEMORATIVE WORK TO COMMEMORATE THE MISSION
OF THE PEACE CORPS AND THE IDEALS ON WHICH THE
PEACE CORPS WAS FOUNDED.**

Notwithstanding section 8903(e) of title 40, United States Code, the authority to establish the commemorative work under section 1(a) of Public Law 113–78 (40 U.S.C. 8903 note; 128 Stat. 647) shall continue to apply through January 24, 2028.
