## A BILL

To amend subtitle A of title II of division A of the CARES Act to provide Pandemic Unemployment Assistance to individuals with mixed income sources, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mixed Earner Pan-  
5 demic Unemployment Assistance Act of 2020”.

1 **SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF MIXED-INCOME INDIVIDUALS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2102(c) of the CARES  
3 Act is amended by adding at the end the following:

4 “(4) In case of an individual who—

5 “(A)(i) would be a covered individual but  
6 for subsection (a)(3)(A)(i); or

7 “(ii) is employed but is unable or unavail-  
8 able to earn self-employment income because of  
9 factors described in subsection (a)(3)(A)(ii) and  
10 otherwise satisfies the requirements of sub-  
11 section (a)(3);

12 “(B) during the individual’s most recent  
13 taxable year ending prior to the individual’s ap-  
14 plication for assistance under this section, re-  
15 ceived at least \$7,250 from self-employment;  
16 and

17 “(C) makes an irrevocable election to be  
18 treated as a covered individual under this sec-  
19 tion for each week, with respect to which assist-  
20 ance under this section is available, that be-  
21 gins—

22 “(i) after the date of such election; or

23 “(ii) before such date, but only if the  
24 individual did not otherwise receive unem-  
25 ployment benefits for such week under this

1 section, section 2104, section 2107, or as  
2 determined under State law,  
3 such individual shall be treated as a covered indi-  
4 vidual described in subsection (d)(2) for such weeks.  
5 An individual with respect to which this paragraph  
6 applies for a week shall be deemed ineligible for reg-  
7 ular compensation or extended benefits under State  
8 or Federal law or pandemic emergency unemploy-  
9 ment compensation under section 2107 for such  
10 week.”.

11 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-  
12 section (a) shall not apply with respect to a State partici-  
13 pating in an agreement under section 2102 of the CARES  
14 Act unless the State so elects, and shall become effective  
15 as determined by such State in agreement with the Sec-  
16 retary of Labor.
