A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Medical
5 Services for Children Program Reauthorization Act of
6 2019”.

7 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL**
8 **SERVICES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM.**

9 Section 1910(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42
10 U.S.C. 300w–9(d)) is amended—

11 (1) by striking “2014, and” and inserting
12 “2014,”; and

13 (2) by inserting before the period the following:
14 “, and \$22,334,000 for each of fiscal years 2020
15 through 2024”.
