A BILL

To ensure access to Pandemic Unemployment Assistance for workers who are unable to obtain child and family care, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Support Working
5 Families Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF PANDEMIC UNEMPLOYMENT AS-**
7 **SISTANCE ELIGIBILITY FOR PRIMARY CARE-**
8 **GIVING.**

9 Section 2102(a)(3)(A)(ii)(I)(dd) of the CARES Act
10 (15 U.S.C. 9021(a)(3)(A)(ii)(I)(dd)) is amended by strik-

1 ing “that is closed as a direct result of the COVID–19
2 public health emergency” and inserting “because the
3 school or facility is closed or only partially reopened due
4 to COVID–19, because child or family care is not available
5 or affordable during the hours work is available due to
6 COVID–19, or because physical attendance at the school
7 or facility presents an unacceptable health risk for the
8 household or the individual in need of care due to COVID–
9 19,”.

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
