Mr. Brendan F. Boyle of Pennsylvania introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

## A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to provide for automatic continuing resolutions.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ban Government Shut-
- 5 downs Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTOMATIC CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Chapter 13 of title 31, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1310
- 9 the following new section:

### " $\S$ 1311. Continuing appropriations

2	"(a)(1) If any appropriation measure for a fiscal year
3	is not enacted before the beginning of such fiscal year or
4	otherwise expires, there are appropriated such sums as
5	may be necessary to continue any program, project, or ac-
6	tivity for which funds were provided in the preceding fiscal
7	year—
8	"(A) in the corresponding appropriation Act for
9	such preceding fiscal year; or
0	"(B) if the corresponding appropriation bill for
1	such preceding fiscal year did not become law, then
2	in a joint resolution making continuing appropria-
3	tions for such preceding fiscal year.
4	"(2)(A) Appropriations and funds made available,
5	and authority granted, for a program, project, or activity
6	for any fiscal year pursuant to this section shall be at a
7	rate of operations not in excess of the lower of—
8	"(i) 100 percent of the rate of operations pro-
9	vided for in the regular appropriation Act providing
20	for such program, project, or activity for the pre-
21	ceding fiscal year;
22	"(ii) in the absence of such an Act, 100 percent
23	of the rate of operations provided for such program,
24	project, or activity pursuant to a joint resolution
25	making continuing appropriations for such preceding
26	fiscal year: or

- 1 "(iii) 100 percent of the annualized rate of op-
- 2 erations provided for in the most recently enacted
- 3 joint resolution making continuing appropriations
- 4 for part of that fiscal year or any funding levels es-
- 5 tablished under the provisions of this Act,
- 6 for the period of 90 days.
- 7 "(B) If this section is in effect at the end of a fiscal
- 8 year, funding levels shall continue as provided in this sec-
- 9 tion for the next fiscal year.
- 10 "(3) Appropriations and funds made available, and
- 11 authority granted, for any fiscal year pursuant to this sec-
- 12 tion for a program, project, or activity shall be available
- 13 for the period beginning with the first day of a lapse in
- 14 appropriations and ending with the date on which the ap-
- 15 plicable regular appropriation bill for such fiscal year be-
- 16 comes law (whether or not such law provides for such pro-
- 17 gram, project, or activity) or a continuing resolution mak-
- 18 ing appropriations becomes law, as the case may be.
- 19 "(b) An appropriation or funds made available, or au-
- 20 thority granted, for a program, project, or activity for any
- 21 fiscal year pursuant to this section shall be subject to the
- 22 terms and conditions imposed with respect to the appro-
- 23 priation made or funds made available for the preceding
- 24 fiscal year, or authority granted for such program, project,
- 25 or activity under current law.

- 1 "(c) Expenditures made for a program, project, or
- 2 activity for any fiscal year pursuant to this section shall
- 3 be charged to the applicable appropriation, fund, or au-
- 4 thorization whenever a regular appropriation bill or a joint
- 5 resolution making continuing appropriations until the end
- 6 of a fiscal year providing for such program, project, or
- 7 activity for such period becomes law.
- 8 "(d) This section shall not apply to a program,
- 9 project, or activity during a fiscal year if any other provi-
- 10 sion of law (other than an authorization of appropria-
- 11 tions)—
- 12 "(1) makes an appropriation, makes funds
- available, or grants authority for such program,
- project, or activity to continue for such period; or
- 15 "(2) specifically provides that no appropriation
- shall be made, no funds shall be made available, or
- 17 no authority shall be granted for such program,
- project, or activity to continue for such period.".
- 19 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 20 of chapter 13 of title 31, United States Code, is amended
- 21 by inserting after the item relating to section 1310 the
- 22 following new item:

"1311. Continuing appropriations.".
