## AN ACT

To express the sense of Congress that the Secretary of Education should provide certain waivers to community learning centers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “21st Century Commu-  
3 nity Learning Centers Coronavirus Relief Act of 2020”.

4 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING FLEXIBLE USE**  
5 **OF SUBGRANT FUNDS.**

6 It is the sense of Congress that for school year 2020–  
7 2021, notwithstanding each provision in part B of title  
8 IV of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of  
9 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7171 et seq.) that requires activities  
10 under such part be carried out during nonschool hours or  
11 periods when school is not in session, the Secretary of  
12 Education should carry out the exceptions included in the  
13 notice entitled “Agency Information Collection Activities;  
14 Comment Request; 21st CCLC 4201(b)(1) Waiver Re-  
15 quest”, published by the Department of Education in the  
16 Federal Register on September 3, 2020 (85 Fed. Reg.  
17 55002), by providing that each eligible entity that is  
18 awarded a subgrant under section 4204 of such Act (20  
19 U.S.C. 7174) for community learning centers may use  
20 such subgrant funds—

21 (1) to carry out activities described in section  
22 4205 of such Act (20 U.S.C. 7175), regardless of  
23 whether such activities are conducted in-person or  
24 virtually, or during school hours or when school is  
25 in session; and

26 (2) to provide in-person care during—
