(B) use the student count data relating to calculating such payment for the fiscal year required under section 7003(c) of such Act.

14 Due to the public health emergency relating to 15 COVID-19 and notwithstanding subsections (a)(1) and (f)(1) of section 1303 of the Elementary and Secondary 16 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6393), for the purposes 18 of making determinations under subsections (a)(1) and (f) 19 of such section 1303 for fiscal year 2021 and all subse-20 quent fiscal years for which school year 2019–2020 data 21 would be used in the calculations under section 1303(a)(1) of such Act, the Secretary of Education shall use school year 2018–2019 data or school year 2019–2020 data,
