Mr. JACOBS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee
on Small Business

A BILL

To prohibit certain business concerns from receiving assistance from the Small Business Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Small Business
5 Aid for China Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON AFFILIATION WITH THE PEOPLE’S**
7 **REPUBLIC OF CHINA.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3(a) of the Small Busi-
9 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a)) is amended by adding at the
10 end the following:

1 “(10) PROHIBITION ON AFFILIATION WITH THE
2 PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.—For purposes of
3 this Act, a small business concern may not—

4 “(A) be headquartered in the People’s Re-
5 public of China;

6 “(B) have more than 25 percent of the vot-
7 ing stock of the small business concern owned
8 by affiliates that are citizens of or organized
9 under the laws of the People’s Republic of
10 China; or

11 “(C) be known to be associated with
12 human rights violations that have occurred in
13 Xinjiang Province, China.”.

14 (b) REGULATIONS AND GUIDANCE.—Not later than
15 6 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
16 Administrator of the Small Business Administration shall
17 amend the regulations and guidance of the Administra-
18 tion, including sections 120.100, 120.110, and 121.105 of
19 title 13, Code of Federal Regulations, to carry out the
20 amendment made by this Act.
