AN ACT

To amend title XXIX of the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the program under such title relating to lifespan respite care.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Lifespan Respite Care
3 Reauthorization Act of 2020”.

4 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF LIFESPAN RESPITE CARE**
5 **PROGRAM.**

6 (a) DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING.—Section
7 2904 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ii–
8 3) is amended to read as follows:

9 **“SEC. 2904. DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING.**

10 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Each State agency awarded a
11 grant or cooperative agreement under section 2902 shall
12 report such data, information, and metrics as the Sec-
13 retary may require for purposes of—

14 “(1) evaluating State programs and activities
15 funded pursuant to such grant or cooperative agree-
16 ment, including any results pursuant to section
17 2902(d)(2)(B)(xii); and

18 “(2) identifying effective programs and activi-
19 ties funded pursuant to section 2902.

20 “(b) REPORT.—Not later than October 1, 2023, the
21 Secretary shall submit a report to the Committee on
22 Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate and
23 the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House
24 of Representatives regarding the outcomes of the pro-
25 grams and activities funded pursuant to section 2902, in-
26 cluding any effective programs and activities identified.”.

1 (b) FUNDING.—Section 2905 of the Public Health
2 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ii–4) is amended by striking
3 “title” and all that follows through the period and insert-
4 ing “title, \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020
5 through fiscal year 2024.”.
