Mr. SCALISE submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 962) to amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit a health care practitioner from failing to exercise the proper degree of care in the case of a child who survives an abortion or attempted abortion.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 962) to amend title 18, United
4 States Code, to prohibit a health care practitioner from
5 failing to exercise the proper degree of care in the case
6 of a child who survives an abortion or attempted abortion.
7 All points of order against consideration of the bill are

1 waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
2 order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
3 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
4 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without
5 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
6 divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Mi-
7 nority Whip or their respective designees; and (2) one mo-
8 tion to recommit.

9 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
10 the consideration of H.R. 962.
