- 1 waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
- 2 order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
- 3 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
- 4 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without
- 5 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
- 6 divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Mi-
- 7 nority Whip or their respective designees; and (2) one mo-
- 8 tion to recommit.
- 9 Sec. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
- 10 the consideration of H.R. 962.
