Mr. MORELLE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8294) to amend the National Apprenticeship Act and expand the national apprenticeship system to include apprenticeships, youth apprenticeships, and pre-apprenticeship registered under such Act, to promote the furtherance of labor standards necessary to safeguard the welfare of apprentices, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 8294) to amend the National Apprenticeship Act and ex-

1 pand the national apprenticeship system to include ap-
2 prenticeships, youth apprenticeships, and pre-apprentice-
3 ship registered under such Act, to promote the furtherance
4 of labor standards necessary to safeguard the welfare of
5 apprentices, and for other purposes. All points of order
6 against consideration of the bill are waived. The amend-
7 ment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the
8 Committee on Education and Labor now printed in the
9 bill, modified by the amendment printed in part A of the
10 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
11 lution, shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amend-
12 ed, shall be considered as read. All points of order against
13 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The pre-
14 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
15 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to
16 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
17 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
18 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Edu-
19 cation and Labor; (2) the further amendments described
20 in section 2 of this resolution; (3) the amendments en bloc
21 described in section 3 of this resolution; and (4) one mo-
22 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

23 SEC. 2. After debate pursuant to the first section of
24 this resolution, each further amendment printed in part
25 B of the report of the Committee on Rules not earlier con-

1 sidered as part of amendments en bloc pursuant to section
2 3 of this resolution shall be considered only in the order
3 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
4 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
5 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
6 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
7 may be withdrawn by the proponent at any time before
8 the question is put thereon, shall not be subject to amend-
9 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
10 of the question.

11 SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time after debate
12 pursuant to the first section of this resolution for the chair
13 of the Committee on Education and Labor or his designee
14 to offer amendments en bloc consisting of further amend-
15 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee
16 on Rules accompanying this resolution not earlier disposed
17 of. Amendments en bloc offered pursuant to this section
18 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 20 min-
19 utes equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-
20 ing minority member of the Committee on Education and
21 Labor or their respective designees, shall not be subject
22 to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for
23 division of the question.

24 SEC. 4. All points of order against the further amend-
25 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee

1 on Rules or amendments en bloc described in section 3
2 of this resolution are waived.

3 SEC. 5. House Resolution 967, agreed to May 15,
4 2020 (as most recently amended by House Resolution
5 1107, agreed to September 15, 2020), is amended—

6 (1) in section 4, by striking “November 20,
7 2020” and inserting “the remainder of the One
8 Hundred Sixteenth Congress”;

9 (2) in section 11, by striking “legislative day of
10 November 20, 2020” and inserting “remainder of
11 the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress”; and

12 (3) in section 12, by striking “legislative day of
13 November 20, 2020” and inserting “remainder of
14 the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress”.

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
