Mr. MCGOVERN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (S.J. Res. 7) to direct the removal of United States Armed Forces from hostilities in the Republic of Yemen that have not been authorized by Congress; providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 271) Condemning the Trump Administration’s Legal Campaign to Take Away Americans’ Health Care; and providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the joint resolu-  
3 tion (S.J. Res. 7) to direct the removal of United States  
4 Armed Forces from hostilities in the Republic of Yemen  
5 that have not been authorized by Congress. All points of  
6 order against consideration of the joint resolution are  
7 waived. The joint resolution shall be considered as read.  
8 All points of order against provisions in the joint resolu-  
9 tion are waived. The previous question shall be considered  
10 as ordered on the joint resolution and on any amendment  
11 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:  
12 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by  
13 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee  
14 on Foreign Affairs; and (2) one motion to commit.

15       SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
16 in order without intervention of any point of order to con-  
17 sider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 271) Con-  
18 demning the Trump Administration's Legal Campaign to  
19 Take Away Americans' Health Care. The resolution shall  
20 be considered as read. The previous question shall be con-  
21 sidered as ordered on the resolution and preamble to adop-  
22 tion without intervening motion or demand for division of  
23 the question except one hour of debate equally divided and  
24 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
25 the Committee on Energy and Commerce.

1        SEC. 3. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-  
2 tive day of April 4, 2019, for the Speaker to entertain  
3 motions that the House suspend the rules as though under  
4 clause 1 of rule XV. The Speaker or her designee shall  
5 consult with the Minority Leader or his designee on the  
6 designation of any matter for consideration pursuant to  
7 this section.
