RESOLUTION

Recognizing the critical importance of military aviation training in the State of Colorado, including training conducted at the High-Altitude Army National Guard Aviation Training Site.

Whereas military aviation training in the State of Colorado is mission critical to the national security interests of the United States by ensuring the readiness of the Armed Forces; and

Whereas the High-Altitude Army National Guard Aviation Training Site is the lone school of the Department of Defense where rotary-wing aviators in the Armed Forces and the militaries of foreign allies learn how to safely fly rotary-wing aircraft in mountainous, high-altitude environments: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2 (1) recognizes the critical importance of mili-
3 tary aviation training in the State of Colorado, in-
4 cluding training conducted at the High-Altitude
5 Army National Aviation Training Site, to the na-
6 tional security interests of the United States and the
7 readiness of the Armed Forces; and

8 (2) directs the Clerk of the House of Represent-
9 atives to transmit copies of this resolution to the
10 President, the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of
11 the Army, the Chief of Staff of the Army, the Chief
12 of the National Guard Bureau, the Governor of the
13 State of Colorado, the Speaker of the Colorado
14 House of Representatives, the President of the Colo-
15 rado Senate, and the Adjutant General of Colorado.
