6 the text of Rules Committee Print 116-38 in lieu of the
7 matter proposed to be inserted by the Senate. The Senate
8 amendment and the motion shall be considered as read.
9 The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided
10 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member
11 of the Committee on Appropriations. The previous ques-
12 tion shall be considered as ordered on the motion to its
13 adoption without intervening motion.
