Mr. BOOZMAN (for himself and Mr. COTTON) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for the transfer of administrative jurisdiction over certain parcels of Federal land in Arlington, Virginia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION**

4 **OVER CERTAIN PARCELS OF FEDERAL LAND**

5 **IN ARLINGTON, VIRGINIA.**

6 (a) TRANSFER TO THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.—

7 (1) TRANSFER.—Administrative jurisdiction

8 over the parcel of Federal land described in para-

graph (2) is transferred from the Secretary of the Interior to the Secretary of the Army.

(2) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The parcel of Federal land referred to in paragraph (1) is the approximately 16.09-acre parcel of land in Arlington, Virginia, adjacent to and comprising Memorial Avenue from the western side of the Route 110 overpass, west to and including the hemicycle used by the Women in Military Service for America Memorial, as depicted in blue on the map entitled “Arlington National Cemetery, Memorial Ave—NPS Parcel” and dated November 25, 2018.

(b) TRANSFER TO THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR.—

(1) TRANSFER.—Administrative jurisdiction over the parcel of Federal land described in paragraph (2) is transferred from the Secretary of the Army to the Secretary of the Interior.

(2) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The parcel of land referred to in paragraph (1) is the approximately 1.04-acre parcel of Federal land in Arlington, Virginia, adjacent to the Chaffee parking lot, comprising 1 structure, and bounded on the northeast by Sherman Drive, as depicted in green on the map

1 entitled “Arlington National Cemetery–Chaffee NPS
2 Land Swap” and dated October 31, 2018.

3 (c) LAND SURVEYS.—The exact acreage and legal de-
4 scription of a parcel of Federal land described in sub-
5 section (a)(2) or (b)(2) shall be determined by a survey
6 satisfactory to the Secretary of the Army and the Sec-
7 retary of the Interior.

8 (d) AUTHORITY TO CORRECT ERRORS.—The Sec-
9 retary of the Army and the Secretary of the Interior may
10 correct any clerical or typographical error in a map de-
11 scribed in subsection (a)(2) or (b)(2).

12 (e) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—

13 (1) NO REIMBURSEMENT OR CONSIDER-
14 ATION.—A transfer by subsection (a)(1) or (b)(1)
15 shall be without reimbursement or consideration.

16 (2) CONTINUED RECREATIONAL ACCESS.—The
17 use of a bicycle trail or recreational access within a
18 parcel of Federal land described in subsection (a)(2)
19 or (b)(2) in which the use or access is authorized be-
20 fore the date of enactment of this Act shall be al-
21 lowed to continue after the transfer of the applicable
22 parcel of Federal land by subsection (a)(1) or (b)(1).

23 (3) MANAGEMENT OF PARCEL TRANSFERRED
24 TO SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.—The parcel of Fed-
25 eral land transferred to the Secretary of the Army

1 by section (a)(1) shall be administered by the Sec-
 2 retary of the Army—

3 (A) as part of Arlington National Ceme-
 4 tery; and

5 (B) in accordance with applicable law, in-
 6 cluding—

7 (i) regulations; and

8 (ii) section 2409 of title 38, United
 9 States Code.

10 (4) MANAGEMENT OF PARCEL TRANSFERRED
 11 TO SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR.—The parcel of
 12 Federal land transferred to the Secretary of the In-
 13 terior by subsection (b)(1) shall be—

14 (A) included within the boundary of Ar-
 15 lington House, The Robert E. Lee Memorial;
 16 and

17 (B) administered by the Secretary of the
 18 Interior—

19 (i) as part of the memorial referred to
 20 in subparagraph (A); and

21 (ii) in accordance with applicable law
 22 (including regulations).

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
