A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to treat certain military survivor benefits as earned income for purposes of the kiddie tax.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gold Star Family Tax
- 5 Relief Act".

1	SEC. 2. CERTAIN MILITARY SURVIVOR BENEFITS TREATED
2	AS EARNED INCOME FOR KIDDIE TAX.
3	(a) In General.—Section 1(g)(4) of the Internal
4	Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end
5	the following new subparagraph:
6	"(D) TREATMENT OF CERTAIN MILITARY
7	SURVIVOR BENEFITS.—For purposes of this
8	subsection, any benefit under laws administered
9	by the Secretary of Defense or the Secretary of
10	Veterans Affairs which—
11	"(i) is received by a child by reason of
12	the child being the survivor of a deceased
13	member of the Armed Forces or of a de-
14	ceased veteran, and
15	"(ii) is included in the gross income of

17	shall be considered earned income of such
