A BILL

To amend the Help America Vote Act of 2002 to add a representative of the Department of Homeland Security from the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency on the Technical Guidelines Development Committee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Voting System Cyber-
5 security Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITION OF REPRESENTATIVE OF DEPARTMENT**
2 **OF HOMELAND SECURITY FROM CYBERSECURITY**
3 **AND INFRASTRUCTURE SECURITY**
4 **AGENCY ON TECHNICAL GUIDELINES DEVELOPMENT**
5 **COMMITTEE.**

6 Section 221(c)(1) of the Help America Vote Act of
7 2002 (52 U.S.C. 20961(c)(1)) is amended—

8 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
9 by striking “14” and inserting “15”;

10 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (E) as sub-
11 paragraph (F); and

12 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (D) the fol-
13 lowing new subparagraph:

14 “(E) A representative of the Department
15 of Homeland Security from the Cybersecurity
16 and Infrastructure Security Agency who has
17 operational expertise in cybersecurity.”.
