Mr. CRUZ (for himself and Mr. CORNYN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans’ Affairs

A BILL

To designate the community-based outpatient clinic of the Department of Veterans Affairs in Odessa, Texas, as the “Wilson and Young Medal of Honor VA Clinic”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF WILSON AND YOUNG MEDAL**
4 **OF HONOR VA CLINIC.**

5 (a) FINDING.—Congress finds that Private First
6 Class Alfred “Mac” Wilson of the Marine Corps and Staff
7 Sergeant Marvin “Rex” Young of the Army were both
8 posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for their heroic
9 actions in the Vietnam War.

1 (b) DESIGNATION.—The community-based outpatient
2 clinic of the Department of Veterans Affairs in Odessa,
3 Texas, shall after the date of the enactment of this Act
4 be known and designated as the “Wilson and Young Medal
5 of Honor VA Clinic”.

6 (c) REFERENCE.—Any reference in any law, regula-
7 tion, map, document, paper, or other record of the United
8 States to the facility referred to in subsection (b) shall
9 be considered to be a reference to the Wilson and Young
10 Medal of Honor VA Clinic.

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
