A BILL

To delay the reimposition of the annual fee on health insurance providers until after 2021.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Health Insurance Tax
5 Relief Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. DELAY OF REIMPOSITION OF ANNUAL FEE ON**
7 **HEALTH INSURANCE PROVIDERS UNTIL**
8 **AFTER 2020.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9010(j)(3) of the Patient
10 Protection and Affordable Care Act is amended by strik-

1 ing “December 31, 2019” and inserting “December 31,
2 2021”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
4 this section shall apply to calendar years beginning after
5 December 31, 2019.

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
