A BILL

To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to improve nutritional and other program requirements relating to purchases of locally produced food.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Kids Eat Local Act
5 of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURCHASES OF LOCALLY PRODUCED FOOD.**

7 Section 9(j)(3) of the Richard B. Russell National
8 School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(j)(3)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “Program, to” and inserting the
2 following: “Program—

3 “(A) to”;

4 (2) in subparagraph (A) (as so designated), by
5 striking the period at the end and inserting “; or”;

6 and

7 (3) by adding at the end the following:

8 “(B) to use ‘locally grown’, ‘locally raised’,
9 or ‘locally caught’ as a product specification.”.
