A BILL

To designate a mountain in the State of Utah as "Miracle Mountain".

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Miracle Mountain Des-
- 5 ignation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds that—
- 8 (1) on September 13, 2018, the Bald Mountain
- 9 Fire burned nearly 20,000 acres of land in the State
- of Utah;

- 1 (2) Elk Ridge City, which is located in Utah
 2 County, Utah, was nearly the victim of the Bald
 3 Mountain Fire, until the fire suddenly halted pro4 gression and, instead of burning into Elk Ridge
 5 City, stayed behind the mountain and spared the
 6 city;
- 7 (3) in acknowledgment of this event, the moun-8 tain holds special significance to the residents of Elk 9 Ridge City, Utah, and surrounding communities; 10 and
- 11 (4) the presently unnamed peak has been re-12 ferred to as "Miracle Mountain" by many residents 13 since the fire that nearly spread to Elk Ridge City, 14 Utah.

15 SEC. 3. MIRACLE MOUNTAIN.

- 16 (a) Designation.—The mountain in the State of 17 Utah, located at 39° 59′ 02N, 111° 40′ 12W, shall be 18 known and designated as "Miracle Mountain".
- 19 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-20 ulation, document, record, or other paper of the United 21 States to the mountain described in subsection (a) shall 22 be considered to be a reference to "Miracle Mountain".
