## A BILL

To amend title XI of the Social Security Act with respect to organ procurement organizations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Organ Procurement  
5 Optimization Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. ORGAN PROCUREMENT ORGANIZATIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1138(b) of the Social Se-  
8 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b–8(b)) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking subparagraph

10 (C) and inserting the following:

1           “(C) relies on a standardized performance met-  
2           ric or metrics that are objective, verifiable, and not  
3           subject to interpretation by organ procurement orga-  
4           nizations;”; and

5           (2) by adding at the end the following:

6           “(3) Not later than 1 year after the date of enact-  
7           ment of the Organ Procurement Optimization Act of  
8           2019, the Secretary shall publish in the Federal Register  
9           a final rule to establish the metric or metrics described  
10          in paragraph (1)(C).”.

11          (b)       CONFORMING        AMENDMENTS.—Section  
12          371(b)(1)(D)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act (42  
13          U.S.C. 273(b)(1)(D)(ii)) is amended—

14               (1) in the matter preceding subclause (I), by  
15               striking “2002” and inserting “2021”; and

16               (2) by striking subclause (II) and inserting the  
17               following:

18                       “(II) rely on the standardized per-  
19                       formance metric or metrics established  
20                       under section 1838(b)(1)(C);”.
