3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Brand USA Extension
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF FUNDING FOR BRAND USA.**

7 Subsection (d) of the Travel Promotion Act of 2009
8 (22 U.S.C. 2131(d)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking “2020”
2 and inserting “2027”; and

3 (2) in paragraph (4)(B), by striking “2020”
4 and inserting “2027”.

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
